Do you like to draw and color? Then this opportunity is for you – we are seeking a cover for our 2020-2021 yearbook, and we know our creative Cubs will come through!

Please follow these instructions carefully. Your artwork could be featured in our 2020-2021 Yearbook!

*Note: Due to the current situation, we are asking for students to submit their entries **via email**. Please keep your original artwork in case it is selected for publication (we may need to scan it on our equipment for publication).*

To create your design:

- Use a vertical 8½ x 11 sheet of plain white copy paper or plain white cardstock.
- Include our school name (**Las Flores Elementary**, or **LFES**) and school year (**2020-2021**) in your design.
- Use your imagination – we’re looking for artwork that celebrates LFES school spirit AND represents this unique school year.
- Markers or crayons work best. (Do NOT use glitter, neon, metallic colors. These do not print well.)
- Proofread – spelling counts!
- Do NOT write your name on the front of your paper.

To submit your design:

- Ask your parent to take a close-up photo or scan of your artwork. (Please keep your original artwork in case we ask for it later. Please keep it in a safe place where it won’t get lost, torn, or wrinkled.)
- Ask your parent to email the photo/scan of your artwork to LFESyearbook@gmail.com by Thursday, January 7. Your parent should include the following information with your entry:
 - Student’s first & last name
 - Teacher/grade
 - Parent’s name and this note: “I give LFES PTA permission to publish my child’s artwork & name in the LFES Yearbook.” (Please note: We will not be able to publish all entries.)

We look forward to seeing your design! Artwork must be emailed by January 7th for consideration; we will announce winner(s) in February.
