Students will need the following supplies:

Beginning Levels

Provided by school: One 9" x 12" sheet of white construction paper
Artist profile slip

If using home supplies: One 8.5"x 11" white copy paper can be substituted

Student supplies: Black crayon with paper casing removed

(1" end piece should be broken off to use flat for stalk and tip can be used for branches and leaves)

**K students may use the Beginning Level Art Activity lessons at the discretion of the parent/teacher.*

Intermediate & Advanced Levels

Provided by school: One 12" x 18" sheet of white construction paper
Artist profile slip

If using home supplies: One 8.5"x11" white copy or 9"x 12" construction paper can be substituted
One any size scrap paper can be substituted

Student supplies: Black crayon with paper casing removed

(1" end piece should be broken off to use flat for stalk, and tip can be used for branches and leaves)
